May 5th and 6th CTC will be also back in Vancouver for the EOP2 training, this might be another opportunity for an event, say May 5<sup>th</sup> from 6:00- 8:00 pm with PIBC. **action: Daniella to confirm a date** (May 5<sup>th</sup> preferred)

<u>Vancouver Island Event</u>- Victoria-based with government/municipalities (David Hume was a previous contact), possible date- using case studies as examples, engaging the public in municipal issues.

April 27<sup>th</sup> to May 3<sup>rd</sup> to coincide with the Dialogue Partners training already going on. action: Lisa to see if at least a social event could be mounted in conjunction with Dialogue Partners training.

Local Government/Municipal Gov't- This could also take place in the fall, but consider the timing of UBCM meeting (Sept 22-25 in Vancouver) (UBCM might also be a possible venue), as well as IAP2 North American conference (Sept 10, 11 in Portland).

<u>Outreach to Engineering communities</u>- many different types of engineers, we would need to target specific sub-audiences.

Also hold an event in the Fall, as well as an event in conjunction with our AGM Nov 16<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup>, CTC will be doing another training in Vancouver- ideal to link our AGM with this timeframe to capture some of the attendees from this training. Possibly doing a Fail Fest at the AGM.

Set a date for confirming these commitments- week of March 9<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup>

Consider possible names for this series of event- branding. What do we we call this? - 'Building Engagement Plans for Success'
